- Extracurricular Activities- Carrs Academy believes in the importance of a well-rounded education and offers a variety of extracurricular activities for students:

- Financial Literacy Course: An engaging program that teaches students essential money management skills.

- Beta Club: A service organization that promotes academic achievement, leadership, and community service. (4th-8th grade only)

- Music: Students can learn and appreciate music through various programs, including vocal and instrumental instruction.

- Art Class: A creative outlet where students explore different artistic mediums and techniques.

- STEM Class: Focused on enhancing skills in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics through hands-on projects and experiments.

- Public Speaking: A course designed to build confidence and communication skills in students.

- Book Club: A collaborative space for students to discuss literature and foster a love for reading.

- Hands-On Learning in STEAM: At Carrs Academy, we believe that education should be experiential and engaging. Our curriculum is designed to integrate hands-on projects, real-world applications, and collaborative learning opportunities. Students will participate in workshops, labs, and field trips that enhance their understanding of STEAM concepts and encourage them to explore their interests in these fields.

Uniform Policies

To promote a sense of community and professionalism, Carrs Academy requires students to adhere to the following uniform policy:

Free Dress will only be allowed on Fridays for this school year and it must be appropriate dress or students will be sent home to change.

- Uniform Attire PK4-2nd: All students must wear a designated school uniform, which includes a polo shirt with the school logo, khaki or navy pants/shorts or CARRS plaid, and closed-toe shoes. No crocs, or sandals allowed except on free dress days. Jackets and Sweaters must be school colors-black, grey, or red and may or may not have the logo on them. Spirit shirts can only be worn on Fridays for spirit day. The rest of the week students must have on a school logo polo or button up style shirt.

- Upper grades 3rd-8th Boys: Black blazer or Black sweater vest with CARRS logo, white button up shirt, black or khaki pants/shorts. Boys may accessorize with a Plaid tie from our school issued plaid-but that is optional.

- Upper grades 3rd-8th Girls: Black blazer or Black sweater vest with CARRS logo, white button up shirt, black or khaki pants/shorts, Plaid skirt can be purchased from our school issued PLAID or khaki or black skirt (Uniform regulation only). Shorts must be worn under skirts. Knee high socks may be worn-but is optional.

Accessories: Students may wear accessories that comply with the school's dress code, such as belts and hair clips, but should avoid distracting items. -

Uniform Maintenance: Students are expected to wear clean and neatly maintained uniforms.

Sick Policies -To ensure the health and well-being of all students, Carrs Academy has implemented the following sick policies:

- **Reporting Absences**: Parents must notify the school by 8:00 AM if their child is unable to attend due to illness.

- **Returning to School**: Students may return to school after being fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication. If a student has been diagnosed with a contagious illness, a doctor's note may be required for readmission.

- **Makeup Work**: Students who are absent due to illness will be given the opportunity to complete missed assignments upon their return.

- Absences:

Regular attendance is crucial for academic success. The following guidelines pertain to absences:

- **Excused Absences**: Absences due to illness, family emergencies, or other valid reasons will be considered excused. Documentation may be required.

- **Unexcused Absences**: Any absence not falling under the excused category will be considered unexcused and may affect a student's academic standing.

Birthday Parties

-Students may celebrate their birthdays at school with their class. Procedure:

- Notify teacher that you want to send snacks
- Teacher will arrange time
- If passing out party invites you must provide enough for each classmate or do not send invites to school.

Discipline Policy

Purpose:

The purpose of this discipline policy is to create a positive learning environment that fosters respect, responsibility, and academic excellence. This policy aligns with the principles of Class Dojo to promote constructive behavior and effective communication between students, teachers, and parents.

-Core Values:

- 1. Respect Treating others with kindness and consideration.
- 2. Responsibility Taking ownership of one's actions and their consequences.
- 3. Integrity Upholding honesty and strong moral principles in all situations.

-Behavior Expectations:

Students are expected to demonstrate the following behaviors in all school settings:

- Follow directions the first time they are given.
- Respect personal space and property of others.
- Use appropriate language and voice levels.
- Exhibit a willingness to participate and engage in learning activities.

-Incentives:

To encourage positive behavior, Carrs Academy will implement a points system through Class Dojo:

-**Positive Behavior Points**: Students can earn points for demonstrating expected behaviors. Points can be awarded for:

- Following instructions.
- Helping classmates.
- Completing assignments on time.
- Participating actively in class discussions.

Class Dojo Rewards: Accumulated points can be redeemed for privileges or rewards such as:

- Homework passes.
- Dojo Bashes.
- Special recognition in school assemblies.

Consequences for Misbehavior:

While we aim to encourage positive behavior, it is also essential to address misbehavior appropriately. The following steps outline the consequences for not meeting behavior expectations:

1. Verbal Warning: The first instance of misbehavior will result in a verbal warning.

2. Reflection Time: The second instance will require the student to take reflection time to think about their actions.

3. Classroom Consequence: If misbehavior continues, a more formal consequence may be assigned (e.g., loss of privileges, additional reflection time).

4. Parent Contact: For repeated offenses, parents will be contacted to discuss the behavior and collaborate on solutions.

5. Referral: Severe or persistent misbehavior may result in a referral to the school administration for further action.

Communication with Parents: Regular updates on student behavior will be communicated to parents through Class Dojo. Parents are encouraged to engage in discussions about behavior expectations and reinforce positive behaviors at home.

Review and Adjustments: This policy will be reviewed annually and adjusted as needed based on feedback from students, staff, and parents to ensure it remains effective and relevant. Tuition Policies

Purpose: This Tuition Payment Policy outlines the payment structure for monthly, semi-annual, and full tuition at Carrs Academy, ensuring clarity and consistency for all families.
